1567 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST.

No declarations were made.

1568 MINUTES.

The minutes of the meeting held on 31 July 2024 were approved for signature by the Chairman.

1569 DISTRICT REPORT.

It was reported that fund from the Airport would no longer be given to support school projects. The September meeting of Rushcliffe Borough Council would be given over to consideration of the draft Greater Nottingham Plan. There is to be a national consultation on the location of polling stations. Ratcliffe on Soar Power station will close on 1 October 2024.

1570 FAIRHAM GROWTH BOARD.

The next meeting of the Fairham Growth Board will be on 25 September and will pick up on the question of dust on Green Street from lorries exiting the soil storage site.

1571 MILL HILL QUARRY.

The County Council has granted an extension of time to the applicant to provide further information relating to their application. This extension will require a response by November. The consultees will then have an opportunity to respond.

1572 FIVE PARISHES GROUP.

The next meeting of the Five Parishes Group is scheduled for 23 September 2024.

1573 WAR MEMORIAL TREES MANOR ROAD.

It was reported that two of the trees planted to commemorate men of Barton in Fabis, who died in World War One needed replacement and it was agreed that this be put in hand.

1574 CUTTING OF GRASS, TOP OF NEW ROAD.

It was agreed that a payment of $\pounds 100$ be made to cut the grass at the top New Road.

1575 DOGS AND LIVESTOCK.

It was agreed to give a reminder through the next edition of the Newsletter to dog owners that they need to be kept under control and especially kept away from livestock.

1576 FINANCE.

The clerk circulated a statement setting out payments and receipts to 31 August 2024. It was agreed that the report be noted.

Cheques totalling £566.99 were approved for payment.
