Minutes of a meeting of Barton in Fabis Parish Council held on Wednesday 14 January 2025

Apologies for absence were received from Parish Councillor Julian Coles and Rushcliffe Borough Councillors Abdrew Brown and Rex Walker.

1591 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST.

In the absence of the Chairman at the start of the meeting, it was chaired by the Vice Chairman.

1592 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST.

No declarations were made

1593 MINUTES.

The minutes of the meeting held on 10 December 2024 were approved for signature by the Vice Chairman.

1594 DISTRICT REPORT.

It was reported that Rushcliffe would be included in a county wide reorganisation for Nottinghamshire and that preferred options should be formulated by March 2025. There is the possibility that additional powers may be granted to parish councils. Grants of £150 would be made available through Nottinghamshire County Council for residents affected by flooding. Work on the electrification of the Midland Mainline is expected to cover a four-year time span and would affect roads in the area. Network Rail will be carrying out work to restore the wall on Marl Pit Hill and this is likely to take four weeks and would result in road closures while it was being undertaken.

1595 FAIRHAM.

No further progress to report.

1596 MILL HILL QUARRY.

A Village Meeting will be held to set out the current position and to consider options on how the Village responds.

1597 POWER STATION SITE.

At this stage it was reported that no commercial contractor has been identified that would be willing to carry out the proposed incinerator for which planning permission has previously been given. In the circumstances it is unlikely to go ahead.

1596 FINANCE.

The clerk circulated a statement setting out payments and receipts to 31 December 2024. It was agreed that the report be noted.

The budget for 2025 – 2026 was approved in the sum of £5,446. The precept requested from Rushcliffe Borough Council was agreed at £5,446 a zero percentage increase on 2024 - 2025

Cheques totalling £311.12 were approved for payment.
