1637 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST.

No declarations were made

1638 MINUTES.

The minutes of the meeting held on 6 May 2025 and the extra ordinary meeting held on 18 June 2025 were approved for signature by the Chairman.

1639 COUNTY REPORT.

It was reported that road closures at Zouch would be put in place to enable works for the replacement of the County Bridge to be carried out.

1640 DISTRICT REPORT.

It was reported that Rushcliffe's Borough Council's proposals for Local Government Reorganisation had been submitted at the end of March. The outcome will be announced by the end of November. A planning application for the Construction and Operation of a Battery Energy Storage System at Winking Hill Farm will be considered at the next meeting of Rushcliffe's Planning Committee.

1641 MILL HILL QUARRY.

The issuing of a further Regulation 25 notice relating to the planning application is still awaited. Once the applicant has submitted a response, it will be necessary for a further response to be made on behalf of the Parish Council and local residents. At this stage contact has been made with some of the major organisations that have responded to previous rounds of consultation. At the earliest, the application could be considered by the County's Planning Committee in September.

1642 EAST MIDLANDS AIRPORT.

It was reported that Councillor Andrew Brown has been appointed to the East Midlands Airport Consultative Committee as Nottinghamshire County Council's representative.

1643 BENCH TOP OF NEW ROAD.

It was agreed to approach Rushcliffe Bough Council establish if it would be able to provide a litter bin at the junction of New Road and Green Street once to bench has been installed.

1644 FINANCE.

The clerk circulated a statement setting out payments and receipts to 30 June 2025. It was agreed that the report be noted.

Cheques totalling £291.00 were approved for payment.
