1452 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST.

No declarations were made.

1453 MINUTES.

The minutes of the previous meeting held on 12 January 2023 were approved for signature by the Chairman.

1454 DISTRICT REPORT.

It was reported that Rushcliffe Borough Council had approved its budget and that the Borough Council's element of the Council Tax would increase by 2%. For those residents in band A to D Council Tax bands there would be no increase, it being met during 2023/2024 by the Borough Council. A planning application for a solar power site on Stocking Lane had been refused as too was an application for a battery storage plant. The next stage of the Local Plan was for Rushcliffe to demonstrate that it had adequate sites for housing over the period of the plan.

1456 FAIRHAM GROWTH BOARD.

The next meeting of the Growth Board is scheduled for 10 March 2023. The issue of the possible impact of dust from the proposed Mill Hill quarry, should it go ahead, on the Fairham site would be raised..

1457 QUARRY UPDATE.

It was expected that a new planning application for the quarry could be submitted in the summer of this year.

1458 ANNUAL PARISH MEETING

The date for the Annual Parish meeting was set for 24 May 2023. And a draft agenda would be circulated to members for consideration.

1459 CORONATION OF KING CHARLES.

It was agreed to examine options for a suitable presentation to Village residents to commemorate the occasion.

1460 EAST MIDLANDS AIRPORT.

The issue of the training flights would continue to be raised. The normal flight pattern would remain as they are. The Five Parishes Group Have agreed to make approaches to join the Airport's consultative group.

1461 POWER STATION SITE.

A response has been provided for the second round of consultation for the Local Development Plan on behalf of the five parishes

1462 PLANNING ISSUES.

Some concern was expressed over the position relating to the Top Yard development, where it is understood that the contractor has gone into administration and much of the work on the site has ceased. The Parish Council's case on the appeal over Rushcliffe Borough Council's refusal to grant planning permission for the Oliver's Yard site has been submitted to the Planning Inspectorate and the outcome is awaited.

.1463 FINANCE.

The clerk circulated a statement showing payments and receipts up to 28 February 2023, the contents of which were noted.
