1648 COUNTY REPORT.

It was reported that the A6006 near Hathern would be closed for approximately nine months to enable the bridge crossing the main railway line to be replaced. A series of diversions will be in place during the period of the works. The East Midlands mayor is giving consideration to how to improve bus connectivity within the Rushcliffe district.

1649 DISTRICT REPORT.

The Community Governance review affecting the parish boundaries of Barton in Fabis was under consideration by Rushcliffe.

1650 MILL HILL QUARRY.

A date has still not been set for the County's Planning Committee to consider the application. A draft petition has been prepared for submission to the full meeting of the County Council requesting a reconsideration of the County's Mineral Plan.

1651 RATCLIFFE ON SOAR POWER STATION.

A planning application is under consideration for the method to be adopted for the demolition of Ratcliffe on Soar power station..

1652 FINANCE.
